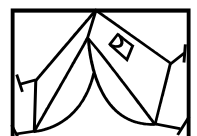
Activities

While you're here, please make yourself comfortable. There is coffee and tea in the dining hall. Please wash your hands before entering and adhere to all signs in the dining hall. Please feel free to fill a travel mug so your beverage stays warm while you are rotating through the groups and their activities. This is a great opportunity to learn with your students in an out of school experience. During the activities we ask a few things of you:

- One teacher will be assigned rotation group, and will be required to travel with that group to each program area. The expectation is to participate and provide *additional* behavior support when need during the progression.
- Please introduce yourself to the staff at the station. If you have any students of “note”, or program requests, a good time to share these things is *prior* to the activity starting
- **Mountain Biking** usually needs the *most* teacher support, especially if a student is learning for the first time.
- Although we ask for support and participation, during the instruction and debriefing of the activity, please allow our staff to facilitate the discussion with your students.
- If there is *time* for the teacher/chaperone to participate, the Summit staff will allow it. Students first!
- **Free Time** supervision (similar to school recess) is supervised by teachers—after meal times—lunch— (~ 20 minutes). This is during our Camp Summit staff meetings.

Keep an Eye Out for...

- Students challenging themselves! Students helping other students! Student accomplishments!
- Make sure to keep note so that you can share with their parents or homeroom teachers.
- In addition to things you see students do, if you see something great from a Summit staff, or something to be improved on, please share with the Camp Summit Host.

Additional Information

- Any communication from student to parent is facilitated by teachers. Students with such request will be instructed to approach teachers or advisors.
- The Camp Summit office has a landline phone available at all times
- Teachers are responsible for administering any student medications and minor first aid care. If major first aid is required, Camp Summit staff will be available.
- Teachers are responsible for evening procedures (bed, bath and beyond). It is important that students know where the teacher cabins are located if there is an emergency. It is equally important that teachers know where the Camp Summit staff cabins are located, if they need further support in the evenings.

Covid-19

Our staff are screened every day with the standard Daily Screening Form. This screening includes temperature, Covid Questions –Signs + Symptoms . This questionnaire has been given to us directly from our Public Health Officer.

In terms of specific activities, know that all activity area equipment will be cleaned after each pod uses them. Students will also wash their hands before and after each activity at our outdoor sinks. Camp Summit is equipped with indoor and outdoor sinks as well as hand sanitizer stations at each activity.

Each activity group will be in a pod for the DAY. There may be free time after lunch, and depending on restrictions at the time, each pod will have their own area for free time. We may ask that teachers help ensure that students remain in their pod for free time.

All Camp Summit staff, teachers and students are asked to wear masks unless they are more than 6 feet from the group. Camp Summit has lots of fun ways to insert mask break opportunities into an activity rotation.

Please note the Camp Summit is located in an area with No Cell Phone Reception. Access to our landline phone and wifi network will be available to supervisors/chaperones and group coordinators only. Wifi location is limited.

Student phones will be collected on arrival and given back on departure.
